

EXPLOSION SIGN 6'9" SONIC - MATT HEUER FOR THIS WEEKEND'S GAME

MONROE, Wash. – May 30, 2008 – He may not be a former NBA player, but Matt Heuer is an employee in the front office of the Sonics and Storm organization. Matt played in limited action last year for the Explosion in a brief three game stint and is excited to rejoin the team.

Heuer is a 6'9" power forward expected to bring energy to the team and depth to the post. Originally from Gig Harbor, Heuer played for the Tide of Peninsula High School. "Matt is very active around the basket," said Explosion General Manager Brad Sturlaugson. "He will be a valuable asset to the team."
