Jay Anderson

The facts: 6-9 forward. Oregon.

Noteworthy: An IBL All-Star after averaging 14.5 ppg and 6.6 rpg for Chargers last year ... Will join the team later this month after finishing season in Romania.

Charles Easterling

The facts: 6-2 guard/forward. Kilgore (Texas) JC.

Noteworthy: Played last year in the Rucker Park Summer League, averaging about 30 ppg ... Averaged 14.0 ppg, 7.9 rpg and 4.6 apg for Kilgore in '03.

Aaron Eneas

The facts: 6-8 center. Oklahoma City University

Noteworthy: Veteran international pro who played most recently in Colombia, averaging 24.5 ppg and 9.7 rpg. Also played in Mexico, Uruguay, Portugal and Poland.

Lamar Harris

The facts: 6-8 forward. Colorado.

Noteworthy: Ranked fifth in the Big 12 in rebounds (8.5 rpg) in 2004 ... Averaged 12.4 ppg and 8.4 rpg at Compton CC before transferring.

Gary Lenoir

The facts: 6-0 guard. Emporia State (Kan.).

Noteworthy: Named best all-around player at Emporia State ... Listed as "Dribbling Specialist" for local Game Time Basketball Academy.

Antwon Mills

The facts: 6-8 forward. Fresno Pacific.

Noteworthy: Only returning player who began the season with the Chargers last year ... Averaged 10.1 ppg and 9.3 rpg in first IBL season.

Tryian Ridges

The facts: 6-1 guard. Union University.

Noteworthy: Known as "The Wiz" for his creative ball handling ... Has played in NBDL, USBL and in Holland and France. ... Became Union's all-time assist leader.

Rodrick Stevenson

The facts: 6-4 guard. Appalachian State (N.C.).

Noteworthy: IBL All-Star last year after averaging 24.7 ppg for Cedar Valley Jaguars ... Also played in Mexico and Portugal.

Solomon Yearby

The facts: 6-3 guard. Campbell (N.C.) University.

Noteworthy: Played for IBL's Aurora Cavalry last season, averaging 30.5 ppg in two games vs. Chargers.

Adam Zahn

The facts: 6-8 forward. Oregon.

Noteworthy: Averaged 2.5 points and 2.1 rebounds as a senior for the Ducks this past season, mostly as a reserve.

Eric Orton

The facts: 6-5 guard/forward. Eastern Oregon/Thurston HS.

Noteworthy: Local product averaged 8.2 ppg for Thurston in '02... Three-point specialist averaged 10.2 ppg in final collegiate season with EOU in '06.

Jamar Bohannon

The facts: 6-7 forward. Metro State (Denver).

Noteworthy: Teammate of Yearby's with Aurora last year, averaging 33 points against Chargers ... Helped Metro State to Division II national championship in '04.
